2017: Oversaw Agencies Responsible for Disastrous Response to the crisis in Puerto Rico after Hurricane Maria⁴ Experts have claimed that many people died after the hurricane because of the weak response and the island still lacks reliable power.⁵



2007: Oversaw Inept Attempts to Fix Error-Riddled Terrorist Watch List⁶

Responsible for fixing errors on the list but told Congress she couldn't guarantee that she could remove someone like John Lewis, a civil rights icon and Congressman who was detained at the airport more than 30 times.⁷
