- Searched FEC database for all 2016-present contributions from employees of debt collection companies Pioneer Credit Recovery, Performant, Absolute Resolutions Corporation, BCA Financial, Cavalry Portfolio Services, Capio Partners, CACI, and CBE to known campaign committees for each current member of the House Financial Services committee.
- Searched FEC database for all 2016-present contributions from employees of debt collection trade groups ACA International, RMAI, National Association of Credit Management, National Association of Retail Collection Attorneys, National Creditors Bar Association to known campaign committees for each current member of the House Financial Services committee.
